

Johanna Saint-Pierre is an emerging French independent artist who already has a great career behind her. She is an amazing pianist, songwriter, and producer, with expertise in electro, soul, funk and pop music. She releases and recorded between Paris & New-York, confidentially, 3 vinyl records, 3 electro-pop albums, 5 Eps, 2 singles between the year 2000 and 2023.

FIRST STEPS:

She asked Marc Ricci (DJ/Compilations Hôtel Costes) to produced her first electro remix Electronic Superstar. The track can be found on the prestigious International Compilation of House Music yepparty.com (Patrick Vidal) distributed by Universal. Johanna then went to New York with her vinyl records under her arm. She has proposals with various independent American labels of electro music. She signed in New York on the emblematic house music label Ibadan for an EP, l'âme éternelle with Jephté Guillaume (bassist of Destiny Child, Wycleef, Billy Preston). Johanna recorded, between 2018 and 2021 still in New York 2 Eps soul pop produced by the producer at the many Grammy Awards Brian Bacchus who signed Norah Jones and produced Gregory Porter. In 2021, the cover of Johanna by Stevie Wonder Sensuous Whisper (label Lilihouse Music /New-York) as well as her original single Don't Stop the Music (Label Passport Songs Music/France) directed by Nicolas Bulostin (Mix for Coldplay, Laurent Garnier, Georges Michael) made it known to regional radio stations and students around the world. Johanna will release her 4th album directed by Nicolas Bulostin in October 2023.

LIVE/CONCERTS:

She performed at **the Longjumeau Theater in October 2020 in France**. **She opened** for the **Kenyan afro pop group Sauti Sol** (MTV Europe Music Award) at the Backstage in **Paris**. She has performed at **the Zèbre** and the **Festival Onze** in **Paris**. **Johanna performed solo voice and piano**

for a first U.S. tour in 2018 in North Carolina and performed in New York City in July 2019. Listen to her, feel her emotion, she is like an angel singing near your ears. She is fascinating and an incredible stage performer. Live music is a playground!

SYNCHRO:

Two tracks from her second album, The Heyday, appear in Synchro on the soundtrack of Vivian Norris's feature documentary Obamama. It was screened at the Seatle International Film Festival (FIFF) in 2014. Johanna composed the music of 3 short/medium films broadcast on Canal +.

GOSPEL CHOIR IN PARIS:

Johanna is a member of the **Gospel Choir of Paris** led by the Cameroonian Franco **Georges Seba** (Paul Simon, Alpha Blondie, Manu Di bango). With the choir she regularly goes on tour. She accompanied **Pharell Williams** on a French television set (Michel Druker) for the song **Happy**. In **April 2023**, she accompanied **Kassav's pianist**, **Jean-Claude Naimro**, on stage at the Trianon in Paris.

LAPLACE:

She became a pop/rock musician with the Rock Laplace band with which she opened for the **Rolling Stones** at The **Olympia** in 1995 in **Paris.** The group signed with Canal +/La Bande Son and was sponsored by Pepsi. With Laplace she also opened for **the Simple Minds during a tour** in France. Laplace did after that **a own tour** and play at The **Cigale** in Paris. At that time Johanna was a student of musicology **at the Sorbonne in classical piano** and also at a **jazz school in Paris**.
